

## RESOLUTION 3-01


A resolution of the Town Council of the Town of Whitehall, Montana, of its intention to object to conducting the November 6, 2001 Election of Officers by mail ballot.

## RESOLUTION 2-01


A resolution of the Town Council of the Town of Whitehall, Montana relating to approval of the 2001 - 2002 final budget and approval of the street lighting improvement district:




## RESOLUTION 3-00

## RESOLUTION NO. 2-00

### Resolution of the Town of Whitehall, Montana Authorizing Charges for Fire Protection to Private, Non-Fire District Persons or Entitys

#### Recitals

The Town Council of the Town of Whitehall, Montana has determined there to be a need to charge a fee for the use of their fire equipment and personnel where they are called to perform services for non-district fires, due to the cost of such services and the non-payment for those services, and therefore:

Be it resolved, that the Town of Whitehall, Montana, of the County of Jefferson, State of Montana, in pursuance to statutory authority hereby authorize the Mayor of the Town to enter and set fees in concert with the local fire department for responding to fire calls for individuals, businesses, corporations and other entities not generally paying any fees within the fire district, either directly or through special levies or tazes duly assessed and to charge for the response and suppression of such fires in accordance with such fee schedule.

It is further resolved that the Town Clerk shall be in charge of billing for said services as herein referenced.
